

Snow Learning Day

Windsor Parents and Guardians,

We hope this letter finds you safe and healthy as we navigate through the COVID-19 pandemic. As winter weather approaches, Windsor CUSD #1 administration and staff has developed “Snow Learning Days” to enhance the learning experience by offering a continuation of learning on days of inclement weather. If poor weather conditions are predicted, both schools will be closed to in person instruction and teachers will send home a packet or an email with directions on the work that needs to be completed during the snow learning day. In short, students will work on assignments given by their teacher(s) while at home. A “snow learning tab” under the drop down menu of remote learning has been created on the school website. Specific information for each teacher can be found on this tab.

To ensure clarity, a district message will be sent to all parents and guardians explaining the specific date for the snow learning day. A snow learning day does count as an attendance day in the school calendar. Thus, when using a snow learning day additional days are not added to the end of the school year.

Student responsibility is outlined below:

Students

- Do not report to school buildings. Please check the “snow learning tab” (drop down menu from the Remote Learning tab) at www.windsor.k12.il.us
- Schedule, assignments, and instruction information available by 8: 10 AM. Packets may have been sent home in hard copy form.
- Teachers available 7:55 AM-3 :35 PM to interact with students, and to assist with student questions. Students will need to email staff if they wish to communicate.
- Have materials and technology available to participate in snow learning day.
- Students will have one day to make up work upon return.

*General snow days do still exist as some circumstances may still require a total closure of the district.
